

## Last Week:

The *major truths* that someone must hear, understand and believe about CHRIST should be the truths that *provide the solutions* to the *problems* that man has because of sin!

## Last Week:

People must begin to understand and believe in **the sin conquering power of God**, through Christ's actions on our behalf. They must trust in the power it provides over the consequences of sin and death.

# # 1

God promises to  
forgive believers of all their sins;  
past, present and future.

He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

**Colossians 1:13-14**

In him we have redemption through his  
blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses,  
according to the riches of his grace...

**Ephesians 1:7**

# #2

God promises to  
make believers acceptable to him,  
by counting them as  
holy, righteous & blameless.

That is why his faith was “counted to him as righteousness.” But the words “it was counted to him” were not written for Abraham’s sake alone, but for ours also. Righteousness will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord.

**Romans 4:22-24**

So he is the father of all who believe but are not circumcised, in order that righteousness might be credited to them.

**Romans 4:11**

This righteousness is given through faith  
in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There  
is no difference between Jew and  
Gentile...Romans 3:22

...he has now reconciled in his body of  
flesh by his death, in order to present  
you holy and blameless and above  
reproach before him.

**Colossians 1:22**

...that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.

**Ephesians 5:26-27**

# #3

**God promises to  
remove his wrath against sin,  
from the believer and remove all hostility  
between him and the believer and give  
him/her total peace with himself.**

God has not destined us for wrath,  
but for obtaining salvation through  
our Lord Jesus Christ...

**1 Thessalonians 5:9**

...you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

**1 Thessalonians 1:9-10**

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

**Romans 5:1-2**

This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him.

**Ephesians 3:11-13**

# #4

**God promises to  
make the believer his own child  
and adopt him/her into his family.**

But to all who believed him and  
accepted him, he gave the right to  
become children of God.

John 1:12

You are all sons of God through  
faith in Christ Jesus.

**Galatians 3:26**

God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure.

**1 John 3:1**

Behold what manner of love the  
Father has given to us, that  
we should be called children of God.

And that is what we are!

**Ephesians 1:5**

# #5

God promises to  
bring the believer to himself by  
raising him/her from the dead  
after they die.

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from  
the dead dwells in you, he who raised  
Christ Jesus from the dead  
will also give life to your mortal bodies  
through his Spirit who dwells in you.

**Romans 8:11**

And God will raise us from the dead  
by his power, just as he raised our Lord  
from the dead. 1 Corinthians 6:14

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the  
righteous for the unrighteous,  
to bring you to God. He was put to death in  
the body but made alive in the Spirit.

**1 Peter 3:18**

For he has rescued us from the  
dominion of darkness and brought us  
into the kingdom of the Son he loves...

Colossians 1:13

# #6

**God promises that  
the believer will  
be free from condemnation  
and judgement!**

Therefore there is now  
no condemnation for those  
who are in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:1

**Whoever believes in him is not condemned,**

**but whoever does not believe stands  
condemned already because they have  
not believed in the name of God's one**

**and only Son. John 3:18**

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

**John 5:24**

# #7

**God promises that  
the believer's name will  
be written in the book of life  
and he/she will have eternal life.**

Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.

**Luke 10:20**

But at that time your people—  
everyone whose name is found written in the  
book--will be delivered. And many of those  
who sleep in the dust of the earth shall  
awake, some to everlasting life, and some to  
shame and everlasting contempt.

**Daniel 12:1-2**

I write these things to you who believe  
in the name of the Son of God, that you  
may know that you have eternal life.

**1 John 5:13**

For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

**John 6:40**

# #8

God promises that  
the believer will  
escape the punishment of hell and  
eternal separation from God.

Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged... Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

**Revelation 20:13-15**




summary

In evangelism, people  
must **hear, understand** and **believe**  
some of the MAIN things which  
**God promises to do with those**  
**who are IN CHRIST.**

A person must begin to understand and **believe that those things are true of them** and they must be convinced that God will forgive them, does count them righteous, will raise them from the dead & will give them eternal life etc.
