'I am the LORD. I will free you from your oppression and will rescue you from your slavery in Egypt. I will redeem you with a powerful arm and great acts of judgment.



revelation.




Yahweh is righteous. He loves a righteous way of life. Virtuous people will see his face. (Ps. 11:7)

<sup>5</sup> Never worship them or serve them, because I, Yahweh your Elohim, am El Kanna....(Ex 20)


This name declares His love for righteousness.
