God Reveals His Name

God Reveals His Name

Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you? (1 Cor 3:16)

God Reveals His Name

¹⁹ Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, ²⁰ for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body. (2 Cor 6)

Understanding His Name

³⁵ He showed you these things so you would know that the LORD is God and there is no other. (Deut 4)

Understanding His Name

³⁶ He let you hear his voice from heaven so he could instruct you. He let you see his great fire here on earth so he could speak to you from it. (Deut 4)

Understanding His Name

³⁷ Because he loved your ancestors, he chose to bless their descendants, and he personally brought you out of Egypt with a great display of power. (Deut 4)

Understanding His Name

³⁸ He drove out nations far greater than you, so he could bring you in and give you their land as your special possession, as it is today.
(Deut 4)

Understanding His Name

³⁹ “So remember this and keep it firmly in mind: The LORD is God both in heaven and on earth, and there is no other.
(Deut 4)

Promises

²¹ We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord. ²² Through him you Gentiles are also being made part of this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit. (Ep 2)

Promises

Then one of the seven angels who held the seven bowls containing the seven last plagues came and said to me, “Come with me! I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.” (Rev. 21:9)

Promises

(EX 33) ¹⁴ The LORD replied, “I will personally go with you, Moses, and I will give you rest —everything will be fine for you.”

Promises

(2 Cr 7:1) When Solomon finished praying, fire flashed down from heaven and burned up the burnt offerings and sacrifices, and the glorious presence of the LORD filled the Temple.

Promises
