







## Appraisal #1 The Hatred of the Jewish Leaders

<sup>47</sup> So the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered the council and said, "What are we to do? For this man performs many signs.
<sup>48</sup> <u>If we let him go</u> on like this, everyone will believe in him, and the Romans will come and take away both <u>our place and our nation</u>."
<sup>49</sup> But one of them, Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all. <sup>50</sup> Nor do you understand that it is better for you that one man should die for the people, <u>not that the whole nation should perish</u>." <sup>51</sup> He did not say this of his own accord, but being high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the nation, <sup>52</sup> and not for the nation only, but also to gather into one the children of God who are scattered abroad. <sup>53</sup> <u>So from that day on they made plans to put him to death</u>. (John 11)

## Jesus has Negative Value!

## Appraisal #2 The Worship from Mary

Six days before the Passover, Jesus therefore came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom Jesus had raised from the dead. <sup>2</sup> So they gave a dinner for him there. Martha served, and Lazarus was one of those reclining with him at table. <sup>3</sup> Mary therefore took a pound of <u>expensive ointment</u> made from pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume. (John 12)

## Appraisal #2 The Worship from Mary

<sup>4</sup> But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples (he who was about to betray him), said, <sup>5</sup> "Why was this ointment not sold for <u>three hundred denarii</u> and given to the poor?" (John 12)

<sup>4</sup> Some of those at the table were indignant. "<u>Why</u> <u>waste</u> such expensive perfume?" <sup>5</sup> "It could have been sold for a year's wages and the money given to the poor!" So they scolded her harshly. (Mark 14NLT)

<sup>7</sup> Jesus said, "<u>Leave her alone. She did this in</u> <u>preparation for my burial</u>. <sup>8</sup> You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me." (John 12NLT)

# **Jesus' Appraisal**

## Jesus has Unfathomable Value!

### Appraisal #2 The Worship from Mary

<sup>6</sup> But Jesus replied, "Leave her alone. <u>Why criticize her</u> <u>for doing such a good thing to me?</u>

<sup>9</sup> I tell you the truth, **wherever the** <u>Good News</u> is **preached** throughout the world, this woman's deed will be remembered and discussed." (Mark 14NLT)

Jesus has Unfathomable Value!

### Appraisal #3 The Fickleness of Judas

<sup>4</sup> But Judas Iscariot, <u>the disciple who would soon</u> <u>betray him</u>, said, <sup>5</sup> "That perfume was worth a year's wages. It should have been sold and the money given to the poor." <sup>6</sup> Not that he cared for the poor—<u>he was a</u> <u>thief</u>, and since he was in charge of the disciples' money, he often stole some <u>for himself</u>. (John 12)

<sup>8</sup> The <u>disciples</u> were indignant when they saw this. "<u>What a waste!</u>" they said. (Matt. 26NLT)

## Appraisal #4 The Fear/ Love of Secret Believers

<sup>37</sup> But despite all the miraculous signs Jesus had done, most of the people still did not believe in him... (Isaiah quote)

<sup>42</sup> Many people did believe in him, however, including some of the Jewish leaders. But they <u>wouldn't admit it</u> <u>for fear that the Pharisees</u> would expel them from the synagogue. <sup>43</sup> For <u>they loved human praise</u> more than the praise of God. (John 12)

Jesus plus Something has Value!

## Appraisal #4 The Fear/ Love of Secret Believers

<sup>23</sup> And instead of worshiping the glorious, ever-living God, they worshiped idols made to look like mere people...<sup>25</sup> They traded the truth about God for a lie. So they worshiped and served the things God created instead of the Creator himself, who is worthy of eternal praise! Amen. (Romans 1NLT)

## Jesus plus Something has Value!

### Appraisal #4 The Fear/ Love of Secret Believers

#### Do you love the praise from people?

- Do you hide your faith in Christ?
- Do you do good and spiritual things to be noticed?
- Do you draw attention to yourself and your accomplishments?
- Do you resent lack of appreciation or recognition? (quit when there is none)
- Do you give up if you see no tangible results to your efforts?
- Are you jealous of others getting attention?
- Do you hide failures, fears and weaknesses?
- Even lie to create an image to impress?
- Do you try to impress and please people so much you step on others to get a leg up?

## What is Your Appraisal of Jesus?

> Are you like the **Jewish Leaders**? Are you hostile to Jesus because He threatens your domain?

> Are you like **Mary**? Have you wasted your life on Him with extravagant devotion?

- > Are you like Judas, only seeking to use Jesus?
- > Are you like secret believers... love human praise?

<sup>20</sup> My ambition has always been to preach the Good
 <u>News where the name of Christ has never been</u>
 <u>heard</u>, rather than where a church has already been started by someone else. (Romans 15NLT)
 <sup>9</sup> So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. (2 Corinthians 5)

## What Shapes Awareness of Jesus' Value and Energizes our Intent for God?

<sup>23</sup> And Jesus answered them, "<u>The hour has come for the</u> <u>Son of Man to be glorified.</u><sup>24</sup> Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but <u>if it dies, it bears much fruit</u>.<sup>25</sup> <u>Wheever loves his life</u> <u>loses it</u>, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.<sup>26</sup> <u>If anyone serves me</u>, he must <u>follow me</u>; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him.

<sup>27</sup> "Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But for this purpose I have come to this hour. <sup>28</sup> **Father, glorify your name**." Then a voice came from heaven: "I have **glorified** it, and I will **glorify** it again." (John 12)

## What Shapes Awareness of Jesus' Value and Energizes our Intent for God?

<sup>4</sup> In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, <u>to keep them from</u> <u>seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of</u> <u>Christ</u>, who is the image of God....<sup>6</sup> For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," <u>has shone</u> in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 4)

# 4 Ways to Engage the Gospel

If you engage in the gospel of glory, what you <u>value</u> and <u>desire</u> will change.

Your <u>appraisal</u> of Jesus will change.

# 4 Ways to Engage the Gospel

Willingly Believe the Gospel of Glory

(John 5:44NLT) No wonder you can't <u>believe</u>! For you gladly honor each other, but you don't care about the honor that comes from the one who alone is God.

#### **Regularly Mull Over the Gospel of Glory**

(2 Cor. 3:18NLT) So all of us who have had that veil removed can <u>see and reflect</u> the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like Him as we are changed into His glorious image.

# 4 Ways to Engage the Gospel

#### Sacrifice Yourself for the Gospel of Glory

(Romans 12:1) I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to <u>present your bodies as</u> <u>a living sacrifice</u>, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

#### **Generously Share the Gospel of Glory**

(Acts 20:24) But my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—<u>the work of telling others the</u> <u>Good News</u> about the wonderful grace of God.
