Super Important!

What does His help look like?

He creates <u>favorable conditions</u> or "OPEN DOORS" to speak!

There is a wide-**open door** for a great work here, although many oppose me. (1 Cor. 16:9NLT)

What does His help look like?

He gives us bravery to speak!

O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, your servants, great <u>boldness</u> in preaching your word... they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Then they preached the word of God with <u>boldness</u>. (Acts 4:29, 31NLT)

What does His help look like?

He gives us bravery to speak!

...Ask God to give me the right words so I can <u>boldly</u> explain God's mysterious plan that the Good News is for Jews and Gentiles alike ... So <u>pray</u> that I will keep on speaking <u>boldly</u> for Him... (Eph. 6:19-20)

What does His help look like?

He enables us with <u>clarity</u> to speak about Jesus!

"And when you are brought to trial in the synagogues and before rulers and authorities, don't worry about how to defend yourself or what to say, ¹² for the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what needs to be said." (Lk 12:11-12)

What does His help look like?

He enables us with <u>clarity</u> to speak about Jesus!

Pray that I will proclaim this message as **clearly** as I should. (Col. 4:4NLT)

Help #4 Personal Conviction to Believe
