diakoneo = "to serve"douleuo = "to serve as a slave."


In the NT, ministry is seen as service for Jesus and to other people for God's glory.

 (MINISTRY) We have depended on God's grace, not on our own human wisdom. That is how we have conducted ourselves before the world, and especially toward you.

13 Our letters have been straightforward, and there is nothing written between the lines and nothing you can't understand.
I hope someday you will fully understand us,

14 even if you don't understand us now. Then on the day when the Lord Jesus returns, you will be proud of us in the same way we are proud of you.



²³ Now I call upon God as my witness that I am telling the truth. The reason I didn't return to Corinth was to spare you from a severe rebuke. ²⁴ ... We want to work together with you so you will be full of joy, for it is by your own faith that you stand firm.



Handling False Ministry Accusations

Truth Reply #2

¹⁹ For <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the Son of God, <u>does not waver</u> between "Yes" and "No." He is the one whom Silas, Timothy, and I preached to you, and as <u>God's ultimate "Yes," he</u> (JESUS) always does what he says.

Don't let <u>anything</u> (change in plans) or <u>anyone</u> (false teachers) trouble your confidence in JESUS Christ!

⁴ He <u>comforts</u> us in all our <u>troubles</u> so that we can <u>comfort</u> others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same <u>comfort</u> God has given us.


God Personally Handles His Guarantee

God Personally Handles His Guarantee

²¹ It is God who enables us, along with you, to <u>stand firm</u> for Christ. He has commissioned us, ²² and he has <u>identified us as his own</u> by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment that <u>guarantees</u> everything he has promised us.
