Miracles vs Faith

What is real faith? "to believe" vs 48 > Believing what God said! > Believing in the promises of God! > Believing in the Character of God! "Saving faith is the heartfelt conviction...that Christ is reliable. It is the confidence that He will come through with His promises and that what He promises is more to be desired than all of the world." (John Piper, Desiring God) And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. (Hebrews 11:6)

What is real faith? "to believe" vs 48


³ For the Scriptures tell us, "Abraham believed God, and God <u>counted</u> him as righteous because of his faith."

⁴ When people work, their wages are not a gift, but something they have earned. ⁵ But people are <u>counted</u> as righteous, not because of their work, but because of their faith in God who forgives sinners. (Romans 4:3-5)

²⁰ Abraham never wavered in <u>believing God's promise</u>. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. ²¹ He was <u>fully convinced</u> that God is able to do whatever he promises. (Ro. 4:20-21)

Is your Faith in Action? 50 Jesus said to him, "Go; your son will live." The man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him and went on his way. 6 And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. The your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. (Ephesians 2:6-7) ...he who promised is faithful' (Heb 10:23) We confidently believe that 'The one who calls you is

faithful, and he will do it! (1 Thess 5:24)

Is your Faith in Action? w/ Unseen Rewards How is your faith to the needy? (James 2) 13 There will be no mercy for those who have not shown mercy to others. But if you have been merciful, God will be merciful when he judges you.

Here's your opportunity...

15 Suppose you see a brother or sister who has no food or clothing, 16 and you say, "Good-bye and have a good day; stay warm and eat well"—but then you don't give that person any food or clothing. What good does that do? 17 So you see, faith by itself isn't enough. Unless it produces good deeds, it is dead and useless. (James 2)
