- 6. I am He (the Christ) (8:24, 28)




2. Notice the analogy of how Jesus pictures Himself! (12)

¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "**I am the light of the world.** Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

In him was life, and the life was the light of men. (1:4)

Chapter 6 – <u>Jesus is the Bread of Life</u>. He fills humanities hunger for God. Chapter 7 – <u>Jesus is the Water of Life</u>. He quenches humanities thirst for God. Chapter 8 – <u>Jesus is the Light of Life</u>. He illuminates humanities confusion or darkness.



2. Notice the analogy of how Jesus pictures Himself! (12) ¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." <u>Theology of Darkness</u> ¹⁷ Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. (Eph. 4) ¹⁸ Their minds are full of darkness; they wander far from the life God gives because they have closed their minds and hardened their hearts against him. (Eph 4)

¹⁸ But God shows his anger from heaven against all sinful, wicked people who <u>suppress the truth by their</u> <u>wickedness</u>...²¹ Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. As a result, <u>their minds became dark and confused</u>. ²² Claiming to be wise, they instead became utter fools. (Ro. 1)

²⁸ Since <u>they thought it foolish to</u> <u>acknowledge God</u>, he abandoned them to their foolish thinking and let them do things that should never be done. (Ro. 1)

3. What is our response to Jesus? (12) ¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." Will you irrevocably follow that Light?

- A person following a wise counselor's advice
- A citizen following the laws of the state
- A person following the gist of a line of reasoning

^{20a} These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple;

^{20b} ...but no one arrested him, because his hour had not yet come. ²¹ So he said to them again, "I am going away, and you will seek me, and you will die in your sin. Where I am going, you cannot come." ²² So the Jews said, "Will he kill himself, since he says, 'Where I am going, you cannot come'?" ²³ He said to them, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. It points to a horror which is all the more terrible since being explained. To die in ones sin unrepentant and un-atoned is the supreme disaster!" (Morris)

Notice the contrast! Its HUGE!

8:51 ⁵¹ Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, <u>he will never see death</u>.

(1 Cor. 15) ²² Just as everyone dies because we all belong to Adam, <u>everyone who belongs</u> to Christ will be given new life.

(1 Thess. 4) ¹⁴ For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, <u>God will bring with him those who have fallen</u> <u>asleep</u>.

1 Cor. 2 ¹⁴ But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means.

What does Jesus say to those who reject His claim?

²⁴ I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I am he (the Anointed One, Christ) <u>you will die in your sins</u>."

²⁵ So they said to him, "Who are you?" Jesus said to them, "Just what I have been telling you from the beginning. ²⁶ I have much to say about you and much to judge, but he who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from him." ²⁷ They did not understand that he had been speaking to them about the Father.
²⁸ So Jesus said to them, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. ²⁹ And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him."

How does this become a reality in your life?
