The Attributes of God: Week 1, Preeminence

When we say that God is Preeminent, we mean that:

- -He is supreme and above everything and everyone else in all ways. He has always been, is, and always will be greater in every way than the full sum of everything and everyone else that ever exists.
- -He existed before all things and His existence before all things is the only thing that allows there to be anything else. He has no origin, yet everything outside of Himself has its origin from Him. He depends on nothing, yet every other thing depends on Him, fully.
- -Another key element to the preeminence of God is that **God is solitary** in all of **His attributes**. He alone possess them to the full, to the infinite degree of perfection. He alone is God, He alone is before all. He alone is Ruler, Creator, and Sustainer.
- -Another key element to the preeminence of God is that **God was, is and always will be fully God, fully perfect, fully holy, fully excellent and fully satisfied in and of Himself.** Nothing can be added to Him or subtracted from Him.

"God has **no origin** and it is precisely this concept of no-origin which distinguishes 'that-which-is-God' from what is not God." A.W. Tozer

The preeminence of God tells us that there is One who is; **the cause of all but is Himself caused by none!**
