## def-i-ni-tion

When we speak of the goodness of God, we do <u>not</u> mean: Moral goodness:

God is holy, righteous and morally good, flawless in fact. However that specific attribute would be; 'The Righteousness of God.'

## def-i-ni-tion

When we speak of the goodness of God, we mean:

#### The benevolence of God towards man:

The goodness of God is what inclines Him to be kind, loving, gracious, benevolent and full of goodwill towards mankind.

He is tenderhearted and of quick sympathy, and His unfailing attitude toward all moral beings is open, frank, and friendly. By His nature He is inclined to bestow blessedness and He takes holy pleasure in the happiness of His people. (A.W Tozer)

That God is good is taught or implied on every page of the Bible and must be received as an article of faith as impregnable as the throne of God. It is a foundation stone for all sound thought about God and is necessary to moral sanity. To allow that God could be other than good is to deny the validity of all thought and end ill the negation of every moral judgment.

If God is not good, then there can be no distinction between kindness and cruelty, and heaven can be hell and hell, heaven.

#### Something that is immutable:


Since God is immutable (unchanging), He never varies in the intensity of His loving-kindness. He has never been kinder than He now is, nor will He ever be less kind.

He is no respecter of persons but makes His sun to shine on the evil as well as on the good, and sends His rain on the just and on the unjust. The cause of His goodness is in Himself, the recipients of His goodness are all His beneficiaries without merit and without recompense.



How great is Your goodness, which You have stored up for those who fear You, which You have wrought for those who take refuge in You.



The goodness of God is not simply a theology to be treasured ...but a reality to be felt and experienced.


There was a man who had two sons. The younger one said to his father, *Father*, *give me my share of the estate*. 'So he divided his property between them.








#### When he came to his senses, he said;



So he got up and went to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.




The son said to him, Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'





## That is the goodness of God.


...the Kingdom of Heaven can be compared to a king who decided to bring his accounts up to date with servants who had borrowed money from him.

#### #2


The goodness of God should lift my hands in thanksgiving ...because without a good God I wouldn't have a single thing.

...without faith it is impossible to please God, because (3) anyone who comes to him MUSI Delieve that he exists and (4) that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. Hebrews 11:6

The goodness of God should lead me to **believe** that God is truly good & gracious, eager & ready to DICSS.


The goodness of God should lead me to turn to him with everything ...because I know that in him, I will find more goodness, joy & satisfaction than anywhere or anything **else**.

Then the king called in the man he had forgiven and said, You evil servant! (5) I forgave you that tremendous debt because you pleaded with me.



The goodness of God should give us confidence that God will **iorgive** ...any debt, from any debtor who humbly turns to him as their **iather**.

## (6) Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, just as I had mercy on you?'



The goodness of God should empower us to be good to <u>Others</u> ...the goodness shown to us should be readily imitated and <u>Overflowing</u>.

Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, (8) how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to (7) those who ask him! Matthew 7:9-11

The goodness of God should lead us to take our needs to God in prayer ...knowing that no matter what the response may be, we can trust his good provision.

...we know that (8) in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:28

The goodness of God should lead us to understand that as his children he is always seeking our **good** ...his infinite wisdom plans what his infinite power makes possible for our greatest spiritual gain.

# Matthew 7:9-11 doesn't say that a good God will 'never give us a snake'. (See Acts 28:3)

If the snake bite reveals to the doctor a hidden tumor...praise God for the snake. If the snake bites you on the road to town...trust that there must have been greater danger in the town.

The deer on your hood... was sent here for your good.
