When we speak of the love of God, we mean:

God is patient, God is kind. God does not envy, He does not boast, He is not proud. He is not rude, He is not selfseeking, He is not easily angered, He keeps no record of wrongs. He does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. He always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. He never fails. (1Cor 13:4-8)

When we speak of the love of God, we mean: The <u>concern</u> of God for man:

The love of God is what inclines Him to be kind, caring, gracious, benevolent and full of goodwill towards mankind.

def.i.ni.tion

When we speak of the love of God, we mean: The <u>compassion</u> of God for man:

The love of God is what inclines Him to be forgiving, merciful, gracious, longsuffering towards mankind.

def-i-ni-tion

When we speak of the love of God, we mean: The <u>commitment</u> of God towards man:

The love of God is what inclines Him to be utterly committed to the **'everlasting welfare'** or **'ultimate good'** of mankind.

Getting to the core of true love:



True love is seeking the ultimate good for another... regardless of the cost to self.

True love aims at satisfying people in the glory of God. Any love that terminates on man is eventually destructive. It does not lead people to the only lasting joy, namely, God. Love must be God-centered, or it is not true love; it leaves people without their final hope of joy.

Perfect love seeks the absolute best end for others.

God is the absolute best end in all the universe.

The best end is for every human to glorify him through praise & submission to him.

This end is what will bring the most possible joy & satisfaction to each and every person.

Therefore;

God loves every person to the best possible end, which is that the come into a relationship with him where they can glorify him and experience the deepest level of joy & satisfaction they could ever experience anywhere.



God is the one being in the universe for whom selfexaltation is the most loving act. In pursuing the creation to exalt the creator, he is pursuing us **towards what is the absolute ultimate good** and **what is ultimately best for us**.



There is nothing better than God. There is nothing more satisfying than being in a relationship with him and having our lives fulfill the purpose of bringing glory to him. Therefore there is no greater love than to purpose the creature towards that end...regardless of the cost.

The love of God is not God's making much of us, but God's saving us from self-centeredness so that we can enjoy making much of him forever. And our love to others is not our making much of them, but helping them to find satisfaction in making much of God. **John Piper**

Our definition;

God loves every person to the best possible end, which is that they **<u>come into a growing</u>**, **<u>God-glorifying relationship with Him</u>**... regardless of the cost to himself or the creature.

Scripture;

<u>God so loved</u> the world **that he gave** his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life...Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ... (John 3:16, 17:3)

Scripture;

God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us...Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. (Romans 5:3, 1 Peter 3:18)

Scripture;

In love he predestined us for adoption through Jesus Christ...In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins...<u>in order that we</u>, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. (Ephesians 1:4,7,12)

Unconditional & Uninfluenced

There was never anything whatsoever in the objects of his love that prompted, warranted or sustains his love. God's love is free, spontaneous and unconditioned.

(The only condition is within himself, his character)

Unconditional & Uninfluenced

The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you <u>because</u> you were more in number than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples. (Deut 7:7)



Unconditional & Uninfluenced

...<u>while we were God's enemies</u>, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son ... God demonstrates his own <u>love for us</u> in this: <u>While we were still sinners</u>, Christ died for us... (Romans 5:10, 8)

Eternal & Unchanging



Eternal & Unchanging

God is eternal and his love is eternal. His love has no beginning and will have no end. His love is from everlasting to everlasting. Nothing outside of himself began it and nothing will end it. It never rises, falls or alters.



Eternal & Unchanging

<u>I have loved you with an everlasting love;</u> I have drawn you with <u>unfailing</u> kindness. (Jer 31:3) ...he chose us in him <u>before the creation of the world</u> to be holy and blameless in his sight. <u>In love</u> he predestined us for adoption... (Eph 1:4-5)

The <u>steadfast love</u> of the LORD <u>never ceases</u>; his mercies never come to an end. (Lam 3:22)

The love of God should enable my love to be without **limit**.






The love of God should enable me to be relentless in my loving of others. Christians should be the most radically loving people in all of the world.
