-I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your waysI will not forget your word. (15-16) -Then I shall not be put to shame, having my eyes fixed on all your commandments. (6) -I will praise you with an upright heart, when I learn your righteous rules. (7-8)teach me your statutes! (12)
Application:
1. If we are to obey God, do what is right and keep our lives from troublewe mustbe in the Word of God.
If we are to have consistent times in the Word we must it daily, it daily, our progress.
We must <u>love</u> God's way.
-With my whole heart I seek you (10) -I have stored up your word in my heart (11) -In the way of your testimonies I delight as much as in all riches. (14) -I will delight in your statutes I will not forget your word. (15-16) -My soul is consumed with longing for your laws at all times. (20) -Your statutes are my delight they are my counselors. (24)
Application:
If we are to have consistency in our study of the Word of God we have to come to it. To love it, we have to see it as more than anything else.
2 God to give you a hunger and thirst for the Word of God. Ask him to give you 'the desires of your heart'. He certainly will answer in the affirmative.

## We must <u>live in line</u> with God's will.


- -You have commanded your precepts **to be kept diligently.** Oh that my ways may be **steadfast in keeping** your statutes! (4-5)
- -...when I learn your righteous rules. I will keep your statutes... (7-8)
- -By guarding it according to your word (9)

God's word is truly only a benefit to those who **obey** it or 'guard their way according to it'.

**Obedience:** "careful **to keep**" "observe" "to perform"

When we live \_\_\_\_\_ with God's word, we are kept on a pure and right path.
