## Week 1: Discipleship, the Mission of the Church

Today we want to focus on why **discipleship is the mission of the church** and the primary task given to us by Jesus.

There are many reasons why discipleship should be viewed as the primary task of the church. We only have time to look at a few: The Final Words of Christ, Major Repeated Phrases, and The Pauline Model

(1) Discipleship is the mission of the church because of: The Final Words of Christ
Read: Matthew 28:19-20, John 15:8-10, John 17:16-19, John 21:17
The emphasis of the final words of Christ
(1) Obey my teaching, abide in me and into the world and find others. (Let's call this 'Going')
(2) Find others who you can feed, care for and them into obedience of the truth. (Let's call this 'Guiding')
(3) As you do this; God will sanctify you and them, you in the truth. (Let's call this 'Growing')

Read: Acts 1:8, John 20:21, Luke 24:46-49, Mark 16:15-18, Matthew 28:19-20
Additional Repeated Phrases:
Read: Matthew 4:19, John 20:21, John 17:18, Matthew 28:19  The 1 <sup>st</sup> emphasis of the major repeated phrases:  (1) Obey my teaching and, even to the ends of the world and find others.
Read: John 10:14-16, John 21:15, John 21:16, John 21:17  The 2 <sup>nd</sup> emphasis of the major repeated phrases:  (2) Find others who you can feed, care for, and them into the flock of God and into obedience.

Read: John 14:21, John 14:23, John 15:10, Matthew 28:20 The 3 <sup>rd</sup> emphasis of the major repeated phrases:
(3) God will be with you and you will in his love and in your ability to keep his commands.

Read: Ephesians 4:11-14 The 2<sup>nd</sup> emphasis of the Pauline model: (2) Teach, train, equip, \_\_\_\_\_ and build up others into mature obedience of Christ. Read: Ephesians 4:1, 22-24, Philippians 2:14-16 The 3<sup>rd</sup> emphasis of the Pauline model: (3) Walk together in the light of your new calling and not in the darkness of your old life, obey the truth and in holiness. Let's Summarize: **Step 1:** Making disciples is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ focus of the final instructions of Jesus & is the model of Paul. **Step 2:** Disciples are made when believers out into their world, and through **obedience** to Christ **bear** the fruit of the gospel by **entrusting** the truth to others. **Step 3:** Disciples are made when believers help others by **teaching** them the commands of Christ, feed them the word of God, tend to their needs and equip them to do the same for others. Step 4: Disciples are made when believers help others \_\_\_\_\_\_ in holiness; through baptism into Christ and identification with other believers, cleansing by the Word, sanctifying by the Spirit and maturing in their walk.
