Week 4: Discipleship Phase 2: Follow Me

Phase Two of Jesus' discipleship ministry could be described as: Come & Follow Me

In **Phase Two** Jesus challenged his disciples to ______ to him on a deeper level, by leaving the things of the world and commit to ______ him.

This **Come & Follow Me** stage lasted approximately **9 months** and covers the time when Jesus called men to follow him to fish for people up until he formally chose the **12 disciples**. **Phase Two** is highlighted in all four gospels, but especially in the early chapters of Mark and Luke.

Read: Mark 1:17-18, 19-20, Luke 5:27-28

The major emphasis by Jesus in this stage was the necessity to <u>leave</u> aspects of the world behind and to <u>follow</u> him with heightened commitment!

Phase Two comes with it's own set of disicpleship <u>distinctives</u>. What Jesus requires of his disciples in this stage is <u>distinct</u> from the previous & following stages.

What were some of the core beliefs & core habits that Jesus required of his disciples during Phase Two?

Phase Two Core Beliefs:

- (1) Everyone is **sinful**, no matter how good they may look or live. And no one can be made right before God, simply by changing how they look or live. (Mrk 2:15-20, Mtt 23:26-28)
- (2) Jesus is the only way that anyone can be made right. And it is through **obedience** to him and a right **relationship** with him that we are able to please God in our daily lives. (Jhn 15:3-11)
- (3) The lost have to hear, repent and believe in order to be saved and it is the followers of Jesus **responsibility** to tell them. (Lk 10:1-16)
- (4) The disciples believe that God will **answer** their **prayers** through Jesus. God can and will meet their needs and give them extraordinary grace, power & wisdom as they need it. (Mrk 11:22-24)

Phase Two Core Habits:

- (1) **Obedience/Holiness:** The disciples begin to realize that a ______ in daily obedience is very important to God...but that they are unable to produce holiness in their own striving. Only Christ can fulfill the demands of the law in them. (Mtt 5:17-42)
- (2) A relationship with Christ: The disciples begin to realize that their relationship with Christ is the most ______ thing in their lives. (Jhn 6:53-58, 65, 68-69, Lk 10:38-42)
- (3) A heavenly mentality: The disciples begin to realize that nothing in this world can satisfy their soul's longings and they begin to focus more on what is ______ & spiritual vs. what is ______ & physical. (Mtt 6:19-34, 16:26, Lk 12:19-21)
- (4) **Prayer:** The disciples realize that prayer is their intercom to the God of the universe. Regular prayer becomes more _______ as they realize it's importance. (Mtt 6:5-13, Lk 5:16)

Let's Summarize:

-The 2nd stage of discipleship should focus on building *heightened commitment* centered on a *growing relationship* with Christ.

- -The 2nd stage of discipleship should focus on building, basic, yet *consistent habits* based on *correct beliefs*.
- -The 2nd stage of discipleship is when concentrated effort is made to help *teach others how to pray*.
- -The 2nd stage of discipleship is when we <u>begin</u> teaching others how to study the Bible on their own.
- -The 2nd stage of discipleship is also when we begin teaching others how to share the gospel with others.
- -The 2nd stage of should focus on *growing in obedience* to God's Word and a desire to *conquer ongoing sin*.
- -The 2nd stage of discipleship strives to help a disciple be more *heavenly minded* vs *earthly minded*.
- -The 2nd stage is when we allow someone to take on a larger, more *active role in serving/helping in ministry*.
