In Phase Five Jesus challenged his disciples to *remain in him*, to *bear fruit* and to *go into the world* and ______ the gospel with everyone. This **Share About Me** stage informally began with several short term evangelical trips to nearby towns in **Matthew 10** and **Luke 10** and formally began at the **great commission** & **ascension**.

This Share About Me stage is highlighted in the mid to late portions of all four gospels, primarily in; Matthew 10:1-42, 28:16-20, Luke 10:1-24, 21:13-19, 24:44-49, John 15:1-27, 20:19-23, Mark 6:6-12, 16:14-18 (Acts/Epistles: Acts 1:8, 2 Cor 5:11-15, 2 Cor 5:18-20, 2 Timothy 2:1-2)
