The 9th problem is an ______ problem. -Our next problem is that our death sentence was eternal & everlasting. So the solution cannot be

temporary or partial. It must last forever and ever! See John 6:40, 3:16

The 10th problem is a ______ <u>problem</u>.

-Our final problem is that these wonderful provisions accomplished by Christ are only promised to those who respond. See Rom 3:25-26, 4:24, John 6:40, 3:16, 3:18

-God has provided a **salvation** <u>sufficient</u> for all...but it's <u>benefits</u> are only for those who believe. -Man has to believe what God has said about the <u>problem</u> and must believe in the <u>power</u> in God's <u>provision</u> and the trustworthiness of his <u>promises</u>!

Summary: #1 There are certain truths that an unbeliever must hear, understand and believe about what God has said about what he has done for us through Christ. #2 It appears that the major truths that someone must hear, understand and believe about CHRIST should be the truths that address the major problems that man has because of sin! #3 People must begin to understand and believe in the sin conquering power of God, through Christ's actions on our behalf. They must trust in the power it provides over the consequences of sin and death. #4 People must begin to understand and believe in the saving promises of God, regarding Christ's actions on our behalf. They must trust in what God says will be true of those who believe in what he has done. #5 If someone is to be saved, they must have <u>faith</u> (confidence in the truthfulness & trustworthiness) in the things that God has said regarding what Christ accomplished with his death-burial-resurrection! #6 If someone is to be saved, they must have <u>heard & understood</u> the things that God has said regarding what Christ accomplished! #7 If someone is to be saved, someone knowledgeable must have <u>told them</u> what it is that God has said regarding what Christ accomplished! #8 Our job then is to be well versed in the things that God has said concerning the power and promises behind the death-burial-resurrection of Jesus.
