

Week 7 Evangelism: What God promises to do with those in Christ.

Last Week: *The major truths that someone must hear, understand and believe about CHRIST should be the truths that provide the solutions to the problems that man has because of sin! People must begin to understand and believe in the sin conquering power of God, through Christ's actions on our behalf. They must trust in the power it provides over the consequences of sin and death. People must begin to understand and believe in the saving promises of God, regarding Christ's actions on our behalf. They must trust in what God says will be true of those who believe in what he has done.*

#3 God promises to remove his _____ against sin, from the believer and remove all hostility between him and the believer and give him/her total _____ with himself. (See 1 Thess 5:9, 1 Thess 1:9-10, Rom 5:1-2, Eph 3:11-13)

#4 God promises to make the believer his own _____ and _____ him/her into his family. (See Jhn 1:12, Gal 3:26, 1 Jhn 3:1, Eph 1:5)

#5 God promises to bring the believer to himself by _____ him/her from the _____ after they die. (See Rom 8:11, 1 Cor 6:14, 1 Pet 3:18, Col 1:13)

#6 God promises that the believer will be free from _____ and judgement! (See Rom 8:1, Jhn 3:18, Jhn 5:24)

#7 God promises that the believer's name will be _____ in the book of life and he/she will have _____ life. (See Lk 10:20, Dan 12:1-2, 1 Jhn 5:13, Jhn 6:40)

#8 God promises that the believer will _____ the punishment of _____ and eternal separation from God. (See Rev 20:13-15)

Summary:

In evangelism, people must hear, understand and believe **some of the MAIN things** which God promises to do with those who are IN CHRIST.

A person must begin to understand and believe that those things are true of them and they must be convinced that God will forgive them, does count them righteous, will raise them from the dead & will give them eternal life etc.
