God may be asking us to **'adopt' 1-2 of our closest unbelieving friends...** for 3 months to 1 year (or more)...to **intentionally invest in them** <u>relationally</u> and <u>emotionally</u>...in order to share the gospel with them <u>spiritually</u>.

God may be asking us to also do this as a joint effort in pairs or teams...that is to team up with another believer and 'adopt' an unbelieving friend together...

What should our purpose, goals & strategy be with the person we are adopting?

To intentionally invest in them <u>relationally</u> & <u>emotionally</u>...in order to gradually & ultimately share with them <u>spiritually</u>.

Intentionally invest in:
This adoption must be an effort that is intentional and planned out. It can't be haphazard or
based on a whim. This is a effort to focus in on 1-2 people with a specific
purpose for a period of time!
Relationally:
This effort must begin with investing in the aspect of the friendship. By
relational we mean; building a genuine friendship based on interests and
experiences. We mean the intentional effort to make the friendship
and lasting. We mean taking time to do fun things together; to eat, work, play &
laugh together.
Emotionally:
This effort must gradually move into the more emotional or aspects of the
friendship. By emotional we mean; yourself to be able to offer
advice, counsel and help regarding the more personal parts of someone's life. We mean the
intentional effort to make the friendship go deeper. That is to begin to talk about the more
important aspects of life, death, family etc.
Conduction Coulting at also also as
Gradually & ultimately share:
This effort is twofold. We must gradually introduce more & more truths about God, Sin &
Salvation. We attempt to do so chronologically but remain flexible enough to address the need
at hand. The second effort is to have the goal of ultimately sharing a concise summary gospel
message either when many of the preliminary pieces have been shared or the door is wide
open.
Spiritually:
This effort must gradually move the conversation into the more spiritual or
aspects of the friendship. By spiritual we mean; striving to be able to offer biblical direction
specifically by sharing the core of the gospel message.
